With a classical cast of two guitars, bass, and drums, Bobby, Jimmy, Dave, Andrew and Hank breath new life into the dusty classics, add spice and make them their own. Since 2015, The Monotypes have put on shows that can be perfectly described with Little Richard's famous song lyrics:

"We're gonna have some fun tonight!"

A The Monotypes Show always stands for wild Rock'n'Roll, with fitting suits and ties, multivoice singing, an impressive stage presence and golden confetti. They perform and celebrate hits from artists such as the Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Chuck Berry, Elvis Presley, Creedance Clearwater Revival and Little Richard as if they were songs of their own writing. Recent hits from artists like Taylor Swift, Sia, Beyoncé or Jet shine through new interpretations in the style of the 50s and 60s.

Since its founding in 2015, the band has already rocked over 120 shows in Germany including the main slot on the mainstage of the Golden Oldies Festival, the Hessentag, in a Frankfurt women's prison, as well as headlining some other big festivals like the Bochum Total festival.

In the past 3 years, The Monotypes recorded two EPs and as well as numerous music videos that are available on all known music streaming platforms. In addition, 4 concerts since 2017 were streamed live on the internet. The Band has played with bands such als Laith al Deen or Fools Garden and In former projects, the band members have played shows with artists like The Hives, Nena, Culcha Candela, Christina Stürmer, Stanfour or Juli at national and international festivals.
